# MERIDIAN FUTBOL CLUB

## Team Manager Duties and Responsibilities

In general, the function of a Team Manager is to relieve the Coach from administrative matters so that he/she can devote as much time as possible to the training of players. In addition, he/she is the liaison between the team and the Board of Directors.

Specific Duties Include but are not limited to:

### Registration:

- Obtain MFC Letter of Intent for each player (**page 10**) and coordinate signing day **July 31<sup>st</sup> at 5:30pm.**
- Obtain Birth Certificate on each player and fax to MYSO Registrar
- Obtain Photos of each player, coach and manager and upload to [www.gotsoccer.com](http://www.gotsoccer.com). Notify MYSO Registrar when completed.
- Obtain Medical Release Form for each player. Make sure form is notarized. (**page 11**)
- Make sure all KidSafe Forms are completed online for anyone that will be a coach, team manager or team volunteer.
- When you receive the players/coach passes, insure each person signs card. Laminate cards for protection.
- Coordinate all uniform orders with \_\_\_\_\_.

### MSYO Club Tournaments:

- Assist with planning and execution of Tournaments.
- Contact/telephone teams in your age group to attend tournaments.
- Coordinate team volunteers/parents
- Assist with tournament registration
- Assist with oversight and management of tournament as directed by the Tournament Committee.
- All tournament information will be posted at [www.meridiansoccer.com](http://www.meridiansoccer.com)

### Season:

- Communicate with coach, team and parents regarding:
  - Practices
  - General Scheduling
  - Tournaments
  - League Games
  - Friendly Games
- Communicate practice and training schedule including changes to the Director of Coaching, D1/D2 VP and Site Coordinator. Once recreational season begins, scheduling is very important.
- Communicate with Registrar regarding changes in roster, team formation, etc. **AT NO TIME WILL YOU CHANGE THE OFFICIAL ROSTER. ONLY THE MYSO REGISTRAR CAN DO THIS.**

- Complete any Travel Permits that are required for any games, tournaments, etc.
- Get signed Parental Consent to Travel (**page 12**). \*Make sure notarized.
- Attend any Team Manager's meetings or seminars throughout the seasonal year if you can not make such meetings, send a team representative. All teams MUST BE represented.
- Communicate with parents on monies needed during the season.
- Arrange for referees through \_\_\_\_\_ . Act early to allow adequate time to schedule.
- Communicate and coordinate with Director of Coaching and registrar regarding tournament applications, schedules, travel permits, hotel reservations, directions, tournament check-in, security and supervision of players in hotel, etc.
- Track cautions and ejections during season.
- When necessary, remind parents of Parents Responsibilities (Parents Code of Conduct, **page 13**) (i.e. proper conduct during team play and at hotels, alcohol consumption, etc) to the coach, other parents and/or players.
- When necessary, remind players of Players Code of Conduct (**page 14**).
- During games, sit on parent side at all times unless needed by coach.

#### **Tournaments:**

- You are responsible for doing all tournament paperwork ie, tournament applications, payment of tournament fees, travel permits, scheduling. If assistance is needed contact the Registrar, VP or President.
- Check in team with tournament officials. You will need to show player passes, provide them with a copy of your roster and travel permit (if out of state) and show them your Medical Release forms for each player, birth certificates maybe required so make sure that you have them but please keep them in a safe place.

#### **During Games in General:**

- Assist coach with injured players.
- Read and understand tournament rules and scoring system. Be prepared to consult with tournament officials, coach and parents regarding team scoring, standing and advancement in tournament.
- Have player passes available for each game.

## **Team Assistant Manager Duties and Responsibilities**

Specific Duties Include but are not limited to:

- Coordinate with Manager and Coach on tournaments, open weekends and types of teams/games the coach wants to play.
- Gain a comprehensive list of team managers from across the state for potential friendly competition.
- Contact team managers/coaches to schedule games; coordinate times.
- Schedule referees as necessary for home friendly games. Make sure that the Finance Manager knows how much cash to have ready to pay for referees.

## **OTHER ITEMS**

**(Very Important)**

Managers need to carry a notebook containing the following items for each player/team coach/manager: player passes, player MYSO registration form, birth certificate, medical release, copy of insurance card. Plus all approved travel permits, tournament information, extra copies of caution/ejection forms and any other pertinent team information.

Tab your book and also include a separate section for each tournament. In it, include a copy of approved travel paperwork (if applicable), the tournament application, and host club tournament approval. Additionally, include travel/hotel information passed out to parents and any other correspondence received from the host club. Also have a financial tab for items from the treasurer and receipts. Lastly, suggest a tab for fund raiser information and a spreadsheet for income/expenses.

### **Request for Player Transfer/Release**

If a MFC player wants to be either transferred or released to another club please contact the MYSO Registrar. Remind all parents wanting this type of action that no fees will be reimbursed and that if they owe MFC any monies a transfer or release will not be approved.

### **League Game Report**

You will be required to fill out some sort of paperwork for league games

**NOTE:** All teams need to make sure that they look at the league standings and scores periodically during the season. If there are any discrepancies please email the MYSO President with the details ASAP or call us.

### **Team Finance Manager Duties and Responsibilities**

Specific Duties Include but are not limited to:

- Coordinate with parents to set up monthly payment plan (**page 15**). New EFT option is available. (**page 16**)
- Creating a team budget.
- Open checking account. All accounts should have the Team Managers Name and the Team Finance Managers name as signors. Provide a copy of the account information to MYSO Treasurer. All accounts should be opened under the following example:
  - Meridian Youth Soccer Organization
  - MFC – U12 Boys/Trust Account
- Write checks as necessary.
- Pay coach per diem prior to travel weekend.

- Pay for referee fees as necessary for friendly games.
- Post monthly budget reports for the team.
- Maintaining budget and submit expense report to MYSO for reimbursement. **(page 17)** per Financial Guidelines **(page 18)**.

## **Team Field Manager Duties and Responsibilities**

Specific Duties Include but are not limited to:

- Store and maintain team canopy and benches.
- Transport canopy and benches to/from games and tournaments.
- Set up canopy and benches on sidelines at games and tournaments as needed.
- Help players organize their bags and personal effects on the sideline as needed.

## **Team Travel Manager Duties and Responsibilities**

Specific Duties Include but are not limited to:

- Coordinate Hotel Reservation early. Some tournaments are very popular and hotel reservations need to be made early. We generally like to travel as an organization so check with the D1/D2 VP to see where other teams are staying.
- Check game/tournament schedules regularly to anticipate upcoming travel weekends.
- At least three weeks in advance of a tournament or travel weekend, call prospective hotels to determine availability and cost.
- Verify with Team Manager, Coach and parents the exact number of players and families attending the travel weekend.
- Block out the appropriate number of rooms to accommodate traveling families.
- Negotiate with the hotel if possible a discount or see if the hotel will “comp” the coach/trainer’s room.
- Communicate with team parents, Manager and Coach hotel accommodation information to include:
  1. Hotel name.
  2. Address and contact phone numbers.
  3. Reservation numbers if applicable.
  4. Map from Meridian to hotel.
  5. Map from hotel to soccer fields.

## **Team Extra Duty Manager, Duties and Responsibilities**

Specific Duties Include but are not limited to:

- Coordinate with Concessions Chairman on date(s) team will staff the concession **(Page 19)**.
- Coordinate shift schedule to insure all dates/times are staffed.
- Coordinate with MYSO Tournament Chairman on date(s) team will staff parking during home tournaments.
- Coordinate shift schedule to insure all dates/times are filled.
- Team Devotional Coordinator
- Sponsorship Coordinator
- Team Activities Coordinator

- Publicity/Communications Coordinator
- Team Photographer

## Parent Code of Conduct

As a parent, you represent the Meridian Futbol Club. The action of one parent can affect the image of all of us. This Code of Conduct requires you to act with good sportsmanship and to treat players, coaches, referees and parents with respect. These rules are in addition to MYSO's Player Code of Conduct.

**48 Hour Rule** - If there is a question about coaching during practice or games, the Team Manager or Coach will be available for a conference after 48 hours to discuss. This rule has the benefit of allowing all parties to discuss the issue in a calm manner that does not occur on the field or in front of other players or parents.

**Playing Time** – It is the coach's discretion how to place the team/players on the field. Some things that hinder playing time are as follows:

- Not dressed properly.
- Missing/Late to practice or a game (with the exception of pre-arranged coach-approved activity or doctor's excuse)
- Improper conduct of any kind (i.e. disrespectful/uncooperative behavior) regarding coaches, referees, team members, etc.

### **Tournament Rules –**

- Team Manager must be informed of your hotel accommodations and estimated time of arrival.
- Team Manager will notify players of curfew time after game schedules are received.
- Swimming is prohibited.
- Conduct at the hotel should not include horse playing or loud talk/running in hallways. Remember, your child is representing The City of Meridian, as well as the Meridian Youth Soccer Organization.

# MERIDIAN FUTBOL CLUB

## Player Code of Conduct

As a player, you represent the Meridian Futbol Club in all team activities. The action of one player can affect the image of all of us. This Code of Conduct requires you to play with good sportsmanship and to treat players, coaches, referees and parents with respect. These codes are in addition to MYSO's Player Code of Conduct.

### **TREAT REFEREES WITH RESPECT**

- Never touch a referee except to shake hands.
- Always address referees as "sir" or "ma'am" no matter how old they are.
- Do not talk back to referees. If a referee speaks to you, your response should be respectful and to the point.
- Do not question calls that referees make during play. It is possible that the referee made a mistake; this is part of the game and will not change. Do not let it affect your play or attitude of sportsmanship.

### **TREAT YOUR TEAM WITH RESPECT**

- Listen to your coach. Do what the coach asks of you without complaining.
- Be at practice and games on time.
- Be responsible for your own equipment.

### **TREAT YOUR TEAMMATES AND OPPONENTS WITH RESPECTS**

- Whether you win or lose, do so with class. Shake hands after the game.
- Never yell or criticize a member of the opposing team.
- Never criticize your own teammates.
- No alcohol, drugs, profanity or fighting are ever permitted at a soccer game/practice or off the field. Always conduct yourself in an appropriate manner.

### **TREAT FIELDS WITH RESPECT**

- Fields are expensive to build and maintain. The fields and equipment are paid for by your families through community taxes and club dues. Never damage the fields, goals, nets, benches, fences and corner flags.
- Do not leave litter on the fields or grounds. Always pick up any litter in your area after a practice or game. A quality team or player should not leave behind athletic tape, paper trash, empty drink containers and worn out equipment ect..on the grounds after a game or practice. Offenders may be required to do field service duty.

### **PRACTICE GOAL SAFETY**

- Do not hang, jump or climb on goals. Do not attempt to reattach nets t goal frame.
- Report and damaged or unstable goals to your coach right away.
- Never move or tip goals on your own.
- Practice only with approved goals from the Community Parks.

### **GRIEVANCES AND CONSEQUENCES**

If you can't play by the rules in this Code of Conduct, there will be consequences. The penalties may include reprimands, suspensions of playing privileges, and expulsion from a team or a club. The MYSO may respond to certain actions that take place during events that they sanction, such as the following:

- Verbal or physical abuse or referees including physical contact, threats or profanity.
- Confrontations between players of opposing teams.

This governing body has the authority to impose fines and suspensions above and beyond those imposed by the Meridian Futbol Club.

# FINANCIAL GUIDELINES

2012/2013 Season

1. Teams will be given \$1500.00 to open a team account at Citizens National Bank.
2. All players will pay \$75.00 per month player fee for 10 month period (August – May).
3. If EFT is selected, funds will be drafted on the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month beginning in September 5<sup>th</sup> and will be deposited into a joint MFC account.

Funds will cover the following:

- Tournament entry fees for 6 Tournaments. Tournament funds per age division per season is the following:
    1. U10 = up to \$1700.00
    2. U11/12 = up to \$2,600.00
    3. U13-16 = up to \$3,100.00 per season
  - Coaches pay for games (up to 6 tournaments and 6 friendlies @ \$50.00 per game)
  - Coach hotel expense (up to \$400.00 per season)
  - Coaches per diem for tournaments and friendlies (up to \$15.00 per day or \$7.50 per meal. Up to \$241.00 per season).
  - Coaches mileage for tournaments and friendlies (up to \$400.00 per season)
  - Coaches pay for training sessions (\$35.00/session. Up to 85 sessions/season).
  - MSA Player Passes (\$25.00 per player)
  - MSA travel request fees/Referees for up to 6 friendlies
  - Equipment (up to \$500.00 for U12 and below. \$700 for U13 and above).
4. Finance Manager will submit an expense report to MSYO/MFC D1/D2 VP for reimbursement after the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month. Expense report will include all receipts and copies of banking statements.
  5. Additional expenses (training/tournament, etc) can be attended using funds from individual team fundraisers or cash collection from players.
